Bandit race in Mobile postponed until March 24th

(Blooming Prairie, MN March 2018) – Due to a weekend forecast that features rain, rain, and more rain, the [Minimizer Bandit Big Rig Series](#) is moving its season opening race at Mobile International Speedway to March 24th.

“This weekend looks like a washout,” The Godfather [Craig Kruckeberg \(#55\)](#) said. “There’s no doubt it’s disappointing, but we have to consider everyone’s safety, especially our fans. With the weather forecast being what it is, the best move is to postpone the event until March 24th.”

The plan ensures that the event at [MIS](#) still serves as the season opener.

“Our fans in Mobile were really excited about this weekend’s event, so moving it two weeks down the road means it’s still our 2018 opener, which is really exciting,” Bandit General Manager [Jason Johnson](#) said.

All times will remain the same, with the green flag dropping at approximately 6:30 p.m. on the 24th. The Minimizer [Fan Series Truck Show](#) will also start at 10 a.m. that day.

“It’s going to be huge,” Johnson said. “Even though the postponement is far from ideal, to move it just 14 days on the calendar is a win-win, where the event remains the season opener and our fans in Mobile can celebrate with us.”
